Dan Carr is Assistant General Counsel at Stolt-Nielsen USA Inc., in Houston, Texas. Dan has served in this capacity since 2000. Stolt is a global leader of ocean transportation and storage services for bulk liquid chemicals, edible oils, acids and clean petroleum products. Dan supports each of Stolt's core businesses, including Stolt Tankers, Stolthaven Terminals, and Stolt Tank Containers. He offers hands-on operational and legal support to manage and protect the Company's assets across 26 countries, 6,000 employees, a fleet of about 160 chemical tankers, 13 wholly-owned bulk liquid storage terminals, and a fleet of 39,000 tank containers. Since 2011, Dan has served as the U.S. Owner Representative on the Documentary Committee for the Baltic and International Maritime Council (BIMCO) and in 2019 was appointed to act as a Vice Chair. BIMCO leads the shipping industry in the drafting and production of contract forms and clauses.

Prior to joining Stolt-Nielsen, Dan was an associate lawyer with the maritime firm Healy & Baillie LLP in New York City for three years. Preceding that, Dan was a Senior Claims Executive/Attorney with Assuranceforeningen SKULD P&I Club in Oslo, Norway for five years. Dan graduated cum laude from Suffolk University Law School in 1991. He has spoken at various conferences on the challenges of in-house counsel and various operational and legal challenges facing shipowners, including Somali piracy, the Mediterranean Sea refugee crisis, and IMO MARPOL Annex VI 2020.
