Fotini Ioannidou is Deputy Director of Waterborne Transport and Head of the Maritime Safety Unit in the European Commission since January 2021. She was previously Head of the Road Safety Unit from 2017-2020 and Head of the Human Resources Unit from 2012-16, serving both the Directorate General for Mobility and Transport and the Directorate General for Energy. She joined the Commission in 1994. Her work at the Commission has focused on transport policy, including policy and inter-institutional coordination, aviation safety and air traffic management. Before joining the Commission, Ms Ioannidou has worked as an IT and telecoms consultant for CAP GEMINI in Paris.
