Several cases in which she was involved established important precedent on the Circuit Court level in the areas of admiralty jurisdiction and marine insurance warranties, and additional decisions at the District Court level successfully challenged claims for punitive damages, marine products liability and damages under the economic loss doctrine, a vessel owner's right to maintain a counterclaim against a negligent Jones Act employee, personal jurisdiction and forum non conveniens. In addition to editing the Newsletter for the Marine Insurance & General Average Committee, Julia has contributed to Chapter VII Death Actions in 2A Benedict on Admiralty.
