



USCG Grant Programs

- State RBS Grant Program (FY 2024 funding \$118,104,023)
 - Formula Grant
 - Eligibility Criteria
 - Annually Approved and Awarded
- National Nonprofit Organization Grant Program
 - Eligible 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization
 - Must be national-in-scope
 - Up to 5% of funding available, usually about \$6,000,000
- National Recreational Boating Safety Survey Grant Program
 - \$1.5 million available each year
 - May be a grant or a contract
 - NOFO posted in Grants.gov for 2 eligible agencies



State Grant Programs

5 Elements of State Program Compliance

- 1. A vessel numbering system
- 2. A cooperative boating safety assistance program with the Coast Guard in that State
- 3. Sufficient patrol and other activity to ensure adequate enforcement of applicable State boating safety laws and regulations
- 4. An adequate State boating safety education program, that includes the dissemination of information concerning the hazards of operating a vessel when under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- 5. A system, approved by the Secretary, for reporting marine casualties

There is a **STATE** matching requirement of up to 50%.



National Nonprofit Organization Grant Program

- Funded to 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations
- About \$6,000,000 in funding each year
- Purpose to reduce number of accidents, injuries and deaths, and safe boating experience
- National in scope to nonprofit organizations
- Grants are focused on outreach, standards, conferences, courses, public health and safety equipment

National Recreation Boating Safety Survey Grant Program

- BSX will be fielding a future nationwide survey on boating pending OMB approval.
- NORC at the University of Chicago will help conduct the survey on behalf of USCG
- Survey yields:
 - Nationwide estimate on the number of boaters
 - Estimate of unregistered boats (canoes, kayaks, etc.)
 - Estimates and usage of communication, distress and safety equipment & boating safety courses
 - By-state estimate of boating exposure hours
- Public Comment Period open through Nov 4
