Betcorp (2009)

- Claim against Betcorp in Nevada
- Betcorp applied for winding up in Australia
- Betcorp asked for a stay in Nevada
- Stay granted by Nevada Bankruptcy Court
- Immunity successfully created



Universal approach


- Insolvency has extra-territorial effect
- Automatic recognition of the insolvency
- Automatic stay of all proceedings
- Codified in the UNCITAL Model law
- United States of America



Territorial Approach

- No extra-territorial effect
- No recognition
- No stay
- Netherlands
- Yukos Oil Company









Priorities in the Netherlands

Priority above mortgage is given to

- 1. preservation costs
- 2. crew claims (max one year)
- 3. salvage and general average

But only if such claim ranks

- also above mortgage ex lex registrationis
- and if it also enjoys priority ex lex causae
