**New Business and Open Discussion (3:50 – 4:00)**

The Maritime Law Association of the United States (“MLAUS”) is an Accredited Provider of **New York** continuing legal education (“CLE”). The program will be appropriate for both experienced and newly-admitted attorneys (Non-Transitional and Transitional). 1.0 CLE credits in Areas of Professional Practice can be earned for attendance at the entire program. In addition, the program has been approved in (1) **California**, including legal specialist continuing legal education credit (LSCLE) in Admiralty and Maritime Law, for 1.00 hour including 1.00 hour of General Maritime Law; (2) **Florida** for 1.0 general CLE credit and 1.0 Admiralty and Maritime Law certification credit; (3) **Georgia** for mandatory continuing legal education credit in the amount of 1 hour; (4) **Louisiana** for a total of 1 hour of credit (including 0 hours of Ethics, Professionalism, and Law office practice); (5) **Missouri** for 1.2 total hours (including 0.0 ethics hours and 0.0 elimination of bias hours); (6) **Ohio** for 1.0 general hour; (7) **Puerto Rico** for 1 general credit; (8) **South Carolina** for 1.00 credits (including 0.00 Ethics, SA/MH, and Trial Ad credits); (9) **Texas** for 1.0 CLE hour; and (10) **Washington** for 1.0 CLE hour.
