The *annual dinner* will be held at The University Club, 1 West 54th Street, New York City, on Friday evening, May 5, 1944, at 6:45 P. M. Business dress only is expected.

Our guest at this dinner will be Commander Raymond F. Farwell, USNR., a member of our Association. Commander Farwell has spent 25 years in Naval service. His most recent book "The Rules of the Nautical Road" was published by the United States Naval Institute in 1941. For some time past, Commander Farwell has been lecturing on the Rules of the Road, at the Merchant Marine Academies throughout the United States. In order that the students may understand the subject more graphically, Commander Farwell shows a series of sound films produced by the famous Walt Disney. In 2 or 3 of them Disney has reconstructed several famous collision cases. Commander Farwell has promised to show these particular films immediately following our dinner, and we believe that our members will find them very interesting and instructive.

The Judges of the United States Circuit Courts of Appeal for the First, Second and Third Circuits and of the District Courts for the Southern and Eastern Districts of New York will be invited to attend this dinner as guests of the Association.

Seating will be at tables of ten and seats will be allotted by the Committee in the order in which reservations are received. The charge for the dinner is \$5.00, including tip, for members of the Association; members who desire to bring guests may do so at \$7.00 each. Cocktails will be served at 6:45 P. M. and the dinner at 7:30 P. M.
