ANNUAL DINNER-MEETING

The *Annual Meeting* will be held at the building of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York, 42 West 44th Street, New York City, on Friday, May 2, 1947, at 3:30 P. M., preceded by the meeting of the Executive Committee at 2:30 P. M. At a later date more detailed notice will be given of the subjects to be discussed at the meeting.

The *Annual Dinner-Meeting* will be held on Friday evening, May 2, 1947, in the Belvedere Room of the Hotel Astor, Broadway and 45th Street, New York City. Announcement of the program for the evening will be made later. The Judges of the United States Circuit Courts of Appeals for the First, Second and Third Circuits and the District Courts for the Eastern and Southern Districts of New York and in New Jersey, Boston and Philadelphia are being invited to the dinner as guests of the Association. If any member will advise the Secretary of the names of any Federal Judges from other circuits or districts who are likely to be in or near New York at the time of our Dinner-Meeting, the Association will be pleased to invite them also to attend the dinner as guests.

The charge for the Dinner-Meeting (including tip and cocktails) is \$7.50 for members and \$10.00 for guests, who must be invited by members. Cocktails will be served at 6:45 P. M. Dinner will be served at 7:30 P. M. Business dress only is expected.
