ANNUAL FALL DINNER

The Annual Fall Dinner of the Association, for members only, will be held on Friday evening, November 17, 1950, in the Sert Room of the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel, Park Avenue at 50th Street, New York City. The Judges of the United States Courts of Appeal for the First, Second and Third Circuits and of the District Courts for the Southern and Eastern Districts of New York, as well as the District Judges of New Jersey, Boston and Philadelphia, will be invited to the dinner as guests of the Association. If any member will advise the Secretary of the names of any Federal Judges from other Circuits or Districts who are likely to be in or near New York at about the time of the dinner, the Executive Committee will be pleased to invite them also as guests. The charge for the dinner, including tip and cocktails, is \$8.00. Cocktails will be served at 6:45 P. M. and dinner will be served at 7:30 P. M. Dress will be optional but black tie is suggested.

Under our contract, we are obliged to inform the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel well in advance as to the number who will attend the dinner. It is important, if you expect to attend, that you promptly fill out the enclosed reservation form and send it, with your check to The Maritime Law Association of the United States, to H. In order to assure members of obtaining their fish, those who expect to order fish as a main course should so indicate on the enclosed reservation form.
