POSTPONEMENT OF ANNUAL FALL DINNER

The President after consulting as many as possible of the members of the Executive Committee has, under the circumstances, decided to postpone the dinner. Tentative plans have been made to hold the dinner at the Park Lane Hotel, Park Avenue at 48th Street, New York City, on Thursday evening, November 29th, 1951. NOTE: This date is not yet definite. You will receive a further notice when the date of the dinner is definitely known.
