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## **FOREWORD**

Since the publication of this year's "Blue Book" (Document No. 396), the Association has elected a new President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President and Secretary and three new members of the Executive Committee. Numerous changes have been made in Committee appointments, the By-Laws have been amended and a number of new members have been welcomed to our ranks. Accordingly, the Executive Committee has decided to publish this supplement to the annual Blue Book at this time and to defer publication of the 1957 edition of the Blue Book until next autumn.

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## AMENDMENT TO BY-LAWS

At the Annual Meeting on May 18, 1956, the By-Laws were amended by the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLVED, That the 6th Article and By-Law be amended by deleting the word "annual" and substituting therefor the word "regular" before the word "meetings" in the third line thereof, and that the 10th Article and By-Law be amended to read as follows:

### Regular Meetings

10. The Annual Meeting of the Association shall be held on the first Friday of May in each year, unless the President, with the concurrence of the Executive Committee, shall fix some other date.

A Fall Meeting of the Association shall be held on the first Friday of November in each year, unless the President, with the concurrence of the Executive Committee, shall fix some other date.

Thirty-five active members present in person shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the Association.
