OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW**

The Administrative Law Division of the Maritime Law Association was formed last September to promote the objects of the Association as related to administrative law, procedure and practice. The Division will consider, make recommendations, and take appropriate action concerning matters within its general purposes, including those referred to it by the Association or any of its committees, or by any court, department or agency.

Among other activities in which the Division is currently engaged is the projected publication of a loose-leaf service covering regulations, opinions, orders and other administrative and regulatory matters covering the Merchant Marine. The Division has also been requested to study and comment on proposed amendments to the Rules of Practice of the Federal Maritime Board.

Any member of the Association may become a member of the Administrative Law Division upon payment to its Secretary-Treasurer, Roy Leiffen, of five dollars annual dues. Members of the Association who are interested in administrative aspects of maritime law are invited to become members of the Administrative Law Division and to participate in its work.
