BY-LAWS

OF THE

MARITIME LAW ASSOCIATION OF THE UNITED STATES.

Adopted June 28th, 1899.

1st.—The name of this Association shall be THE MARITIME LAW ASSOCIATION OF THE UNITED STATES.

2d.—The object of the Association shall be to advance the Maritime Law of this country, and to act with foreign Associations in their efforts to bring about greater harmony in the Shipping Laws of different nations.

3d.—Membership in the Association shall not be confined to the legal profession.

4th.—The officers of the Association shall be a President, a Secretary and Treasurer, and an Executive Committee of three, together with the president *virtute officii*.

5th.—The officers shall be elected for the term of one year, or until their successors shall have been duly chosen, and shall have general management of the Association, including the election of its members and the calling of meetings.

6th.—There shall be an annual meeting of the Association on the first Friday of May in each year.

7th.—(Adopted May 3, 1901, amended May 1, 1903). There shall be two classes of members, viz., Active and Associate. Active members shall pay annual dues of Five Dollars, payable in May. Associate members shall pay no dues and shall not have the privilege of voting for officers. Those now members shall elect to which class they wish respectively to belong, and all members hereafter elected shall be Active members, except that judges may be elected Associate members.
