ANNUAL FALL MEETING

The Annual Fall Meeting of the Association will be held at the Meeting Room of the New York County Lawyers Association, 14 Vesey Street, New York City, on Friday, November 3, 1967 at 10:00 A.M.

The Annual Fall Dinner is usually restricted to members of the Association. However, in view of the enthusiastic acclaim of the membership for the Dinner-Dances held in New York during the meeting of the Comité Maritime International in the Fall of 1965 and the meeting in New Orleans in the Fall of 1966, the Association has decided that the Fall Dinner will be a Dinner-Dance for members of the Association and their ladies on Friday evening, November 3, 1967, in the Grand Ballroom of the Hotel Commodore, 42nd Street at Lexington Avenue, New York City.

Cocktails will be served in the East Ballroom and Grand Foyer at 6:45 P.M. and dinner will be served in the Grand Ballroom at 8:00 P.M. Lester Lanin and his Orchestra will supply continuous dance music until closing.

Dress will be formal.

The charge for the Dinner, including cocktails and dancing will be \$22.50 per person.

The Commodore must be advised well in advance, not only of the number of guests who will attend the Dinner, but also of the number of meat and fish courses to be served. It is therefore important that all Reservation Forms clearly indicate a choice of either meat or fish for the main course. The Committee enlists your cooperation in attending to this detail.

In view of the limited number of reservations which can be accepted, the Committee suggests that if you plan to attend the Dinner, you act promptly in completing the enclosed Reservation
