**Saturday Activities, San Francisco Fall Meeting**

**NAPA VALLEY WINE TOUR.** Air-conditioned charter buses will depart from the Mark Hopkins Hotel at 9:30 a.m. for a tour through the picturesque Napa Valley, home of California's limited quantity prestige wines, with a wine tasting and lunch served at the handsome Robert Mondavi Winery at Oakville. If we have fair weather, we expect to visit one of the small older wineries for an outdoor tasting before lunch. The buses are expected to return to the Mark Hopkins Hotel between 4:30 and 5:00 p.m. As only a limited number can be accommodated, advance reservations are essential. The cost is \$12.00 per person.

As alternatives to the Wine Tour there are other interesting activities on Saturday which members can conveniently arrange individually after their arrival, including:

Stanford University/Oregon State University football game at Stanford.

Grand National Rodeo & Livestock Exposition, matinee and evening, at the "Cow Palace" (site of the 1964 Republican Convention) is generally regarded as a predictably outstanding show.

Information for guided bus tours to Muir Woods and other places of interest in the San Francisco area, as well as Harbor Cruises (similar to that being arranged for the ladies on Friday) will be available at the registration desk.

## **A WORD ABOUT WEATHER AND DRESS**

October is usually one of the loveliest months of the year in San Francisco. Although there can be occasional temperate rains, the rainy season has not yet really begun and fog is infrequent. The days are sunny and bright, sometimes brisk and the evenings clear. The average maximum temperature for the past seventy years according to record for October has been 67.8° and the average minimum has been 53.8.° November is slightly cooler.

There's a bit of Boston and/or London in San Francisco's couture habits. The ladies will want to bring lightweight wools and wool or orlon knits for daytime wear. If you plan to go on the wine country trip, it would be a good idea for the ladies to include at least one casual cotton outfit. Suits are ideal for adapting to the temperature changes. If you prefer dresses, remember to include a lightweight coat, and, interestingly enough, fur jackets or stoles are seen on San Francisco streets all year round. Hats are optional. Head scarfs are wonderfully handy when taking a cruise on the Bay. Gloves are de rigueur.

San Francisco men favor light-to-medium weight business suits of a somewhat conservative cut and medium weight sports jackets with slacks for casual wear.

For both men and women an all purpose light weight coat is a good idea both for cool evenings and for the possibility of showers.

San Francisco is a compact and exciting City and you will undoubtedly want to do a lot of exploring, so be sure to bring a comfortable pair of shoes.
