

**THE MARITIME LAW ASSOCIATION  
OF THE UNITED STATES****FALL MEETING 1976****PALM BEACH, FLORIDA****October 26-31, 1976**

As you know, the Fall Meeting of the Association next year will be held at The Breakers, Palm Beach, Florida. This hotel is one of the finest resort hotels in the United States with facilities which should be conducive to a highly successful 1976 Fall Meeting. The Breakers has 570 rooms, all of which have been reserved for the duration of the meeting. Additionally, we have reserved 100 rooms for persons who wish to arrive Saturday, October 23, and 200 rooms for persons who wish to arrive Sunday, October 24. Rates will not be determined by the hotel until this Fall but they will approximate \$70.00 for the average double room, including breakfast and dinner. It is anticipated that there will be two types of double rooms, one of which may be slightly higher than this figure and the other of which will be somewhat lower. Single rooms will also be available. A registration fee will also be charged to help defray the cost of the meeting, but this amount has not as yet been determined.

The Committee will be sending out additional material later in the year covering general arrangements, transportation and other items of interest. We will again plan seminars on subjects of current interest and arrange for tennis and golf tournaments. In this connection, The Breakers has two 18-hole golf courses and twelve tennis courts.

In order to move ahead with its plans, the Committee requires a preliminary indication of intention from the members of the Association. Therefore, please return the enclosed postcard as soon as possible, but not later than August 25, 1975. The postcard is not a firm commitment, but is an essential planning tool for the Committee.
